

Catheterisation

What is Urinary Catheterisation?

Urinary Catheterisation is the act of passing a catheter into the bladder to drain urine.

Intermittent Catheterisation

What is it?

It is a technique that may be carried out by individual themselves (intermittent self-catheterisation), or by health care professionals. Once bladder drainage has ceased, the catheter is removed immediatly afterwards.

- What are the benefits for the patient?
 - Less risk of urinary infection
 - Avoid flow-back towards kidneys
 - Prevent over-distension or atrophy of the bladder
 - Improved quality of life and autonomy
- When is this procedure indicated?
 - Nerve damage from spinal injury or disease
 - Before or after a surgical procedure
 - Urethral stricture



A technique which consists of giving medication in solution through a catheter into the bladder to treat various bladder disorders or pathologies.

When is this procedure indicated?

- Detrusor hyperreflexia
- Interstitial cystitis
- Superficial bladder tumour

Male Incontinence


Male urinary incontinence is a problem that affects millions of men in the world, particularly as they reach the later years of their lives.

This unintentional loss of urine can range from light, occasional dribbles to more frequent, heavy leakage.

A penile sheath or Male External Catheter (MEC) is used in urinary continence problems in men.

Urine bag

■ This is an external device that fits over the penis, secured by an integrated adhesive band. A drainage system (Urine bag) is then connected to the sheath.



Male external catheters are worn permanently:

- They must be comfortable, reliable and must not cause any skin damage or irritation.
- For that reason the choice of the material is of outmost importance.









What is faecal incontinence?

Faecal incontinence is the involuntary loss of stools from the anus. This can result in embarrassment, distress and an impaired quality of life for patient. The faecal collector can make life easier and much more comfortable for patients and for the healthcare professionals.

Description

Drainable pouch with a total skin protector specifically fitted to the patient's anatomy to collect faeces:

- 1 adhesive total skin protector
- 1 transparent drainable pouch
- 1 emptying device outlet
- 1 connector



- Only one application per day
- Protection from odour and from infections as the pouch is waterproof
- Prevention of irritation and pressure sores by avoiding contact of the patients faeces with the skin
- Time saving: one pouch per day instead of 5 to 10 changes a day
